1. Choose a topic that you want to write about. Try to pick something common or that you know a lot about. Let's write about a:

3. Don't worry if you have trouble thinking of words that begin with tricky letters like **X**, **Y**, or **Z**. Try looking for words in a dictionary, or ask an adult to give you some ideas.






Alphabet Poetry






