A diamante (dee-uh-mon-tay) is a poem in the shape of a diamond. It has this shape because each line has a specific number of words. Diamantes are always about nouns. They are written in a pattern.

1. Before you pick a noun for your diamante, you should know the pattern:

- 2. Now, pick a noun about which to write. This word will be the first and last lines of your poem. Everything between will be about that word, so make sure to pick something about which you can write a lot. For example, you might write about a family member.




